Students are to go the link below and complete the chapter test 1-11. Each test completed **according to the rubric below** equals 1 bonus point the next year up to 11 bonus points. Make sure you follow the rubric carefully, all work must be attached. Any test that scores below 12 out 14 correct can be adjusted to qualify for a bonus point by completing and scoring well on the corresponding chapter quizzes. Follow the rubric checklist below.

1.	Click on Assessment and take a chapter test.	
2.	Write all problems and work on separate piece of paper. NO CREDIT FOR ANY TEST THAT DOES NOT PROVIDE ALL THE PROBLEMS AND WORK.	
3.	Print computer scored results of test and attach as well.	
	If you completed at least 12 out 14 or 85% correct you are done with this chapter. +1pt. a following year test. Go to the next chapter test.	
	Scored below an 85 or get less than 12 correct? Complete one quiz for every missed problem over 2. Do the following:	
4.	Click on any option in the Help with the Math section to review the material. Try the @hometutor or Video Tutor with Practice. They are great! They will help you review the lessons you are weak on. They teach each lesson in the chapter. When you know the material take a quiz.	
5.	Go to Lesson Quizzes for the chapter you are and complete a quiz on your own paper writing the problem, showing all work and giving the answer. Attach this to the test. NO CREDIT IS GIVEN FOR QUIZZES THAT DO NOT PROVIDE ALL THE WORK.	
6.	Print out scored results and attach to the chapter test if the score is 4 out of 5 correct. Each completed quiz,(4 out of 5 correct) brings chapter test grade up 5 points. (This is equivalent to correcting one missed problem on your test.) If you do not score 4 out of 5 correct, try again and review material until you do.	
	Example: If you score 71 on the chapter test, or 10 correct out of 14 you need to complete 2 quizzes (to bring your total of correct problems up to 12) and score 4 out of 5 correct on each one to bring your test up to an 85 (or 12 out of 14 correct) before you proceed to the next chapter.

7.	Print out scored results and attach to the chapter test if the score is 4 out of 5 correct. Each completed quiz, (4 out of 5 correct) brings chapter test grade up 5 points. If you do not score 4 out of 5 correct, try again and review material until you do.	
	Example: If you score 70 or 14 out of 20 correct on the chapter test you need to complete 3 quizzes and score 4 out of 5 correct on each one to bring your test up to an 85 before you proceed to the next chapter.
